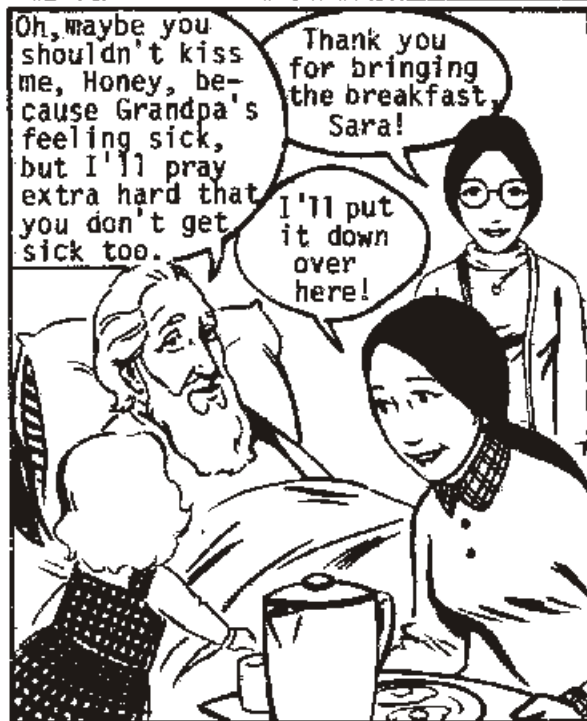
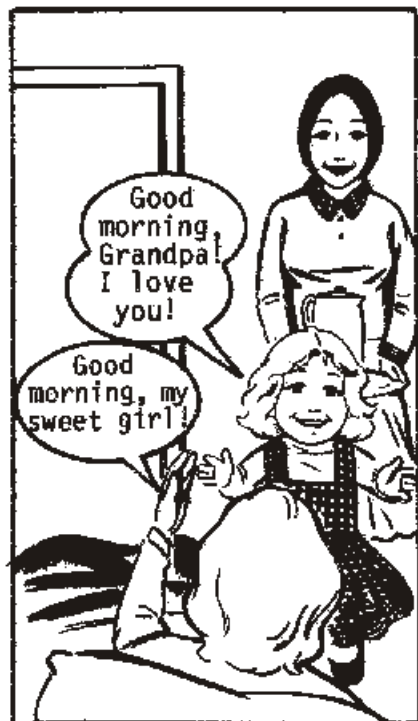


GRANDPA AND TECHI FIGHTING THE DEVIL!

Dead?

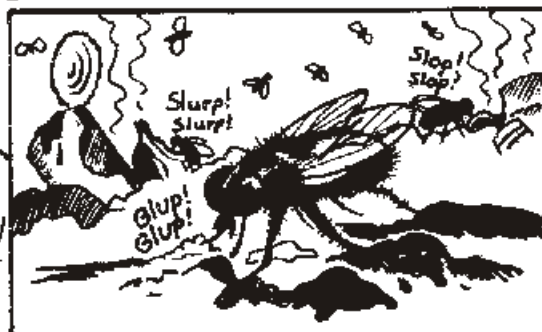
No! The Christian soldiers are too good, too strong and too fast! If I send in any more of my dirty little pests they will kill them too!


There's a dead cockroach!



The Devil was just sending flies, but now there's a cockroach!


Oh my goodness! That's another dirty little devil! A little demon cockroach!

You should always pick them up with a piece of tissue, never with your fingers!




Got him! Fly number seven!


Oh, look! Here's another fly right here!



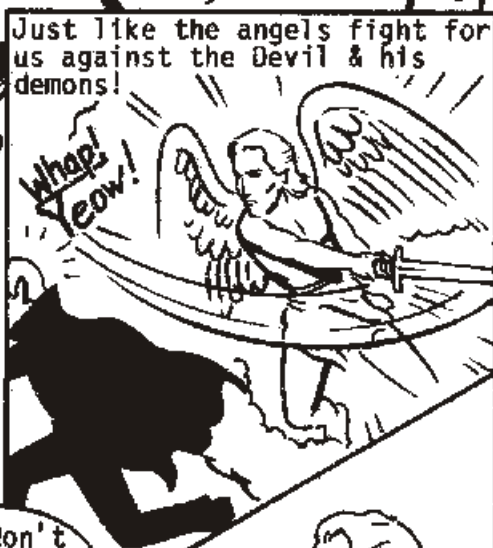
This is like the seven devils that Jesus drove out of Mary Magdalene when she got saved! We did just like Jesus did! We killed seven devils!

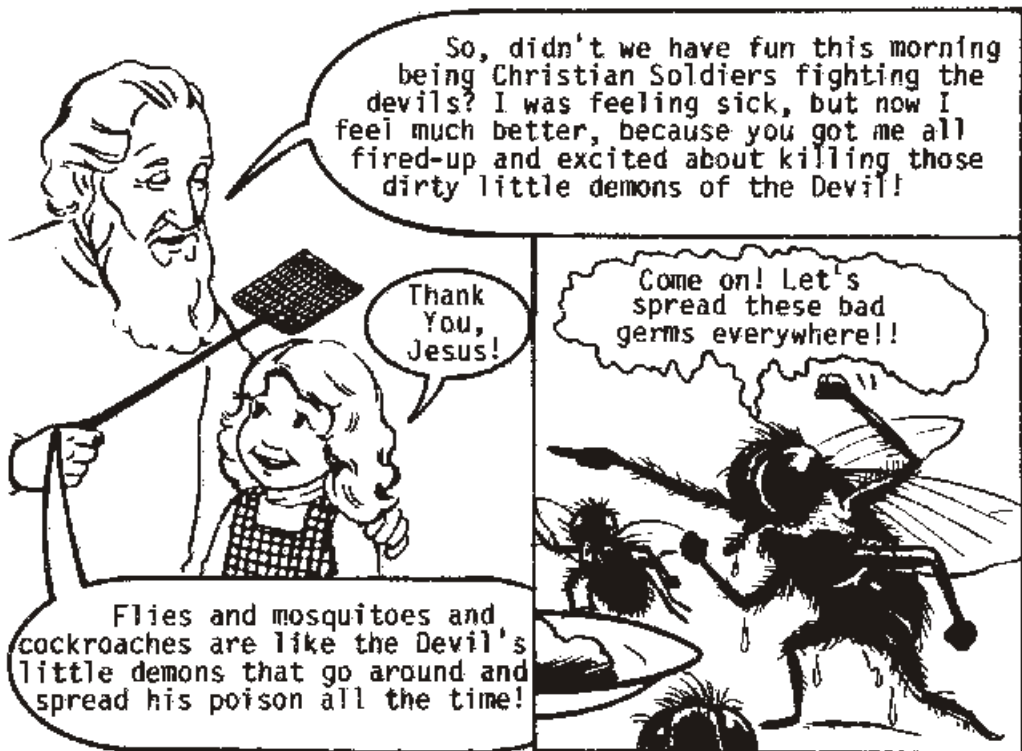


There's another one! I pushed him out the window! He flew away!



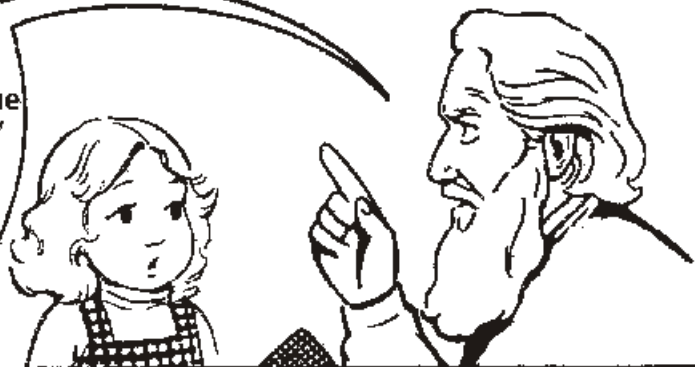

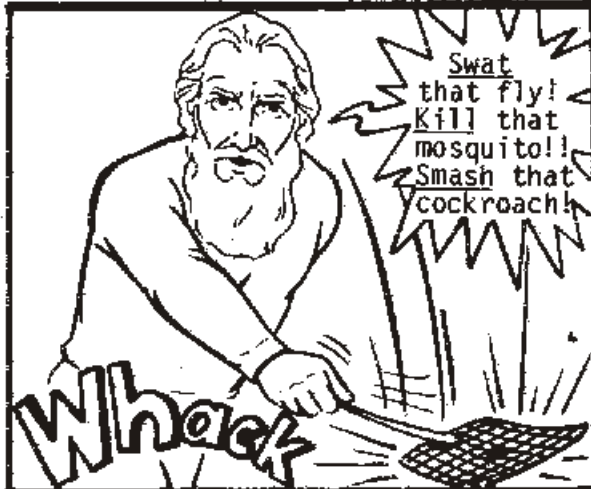
