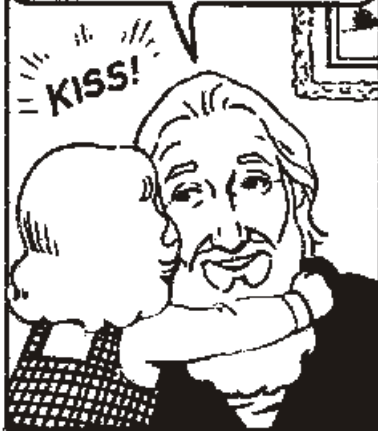


TECHI AND THE DAILY MIGHT!

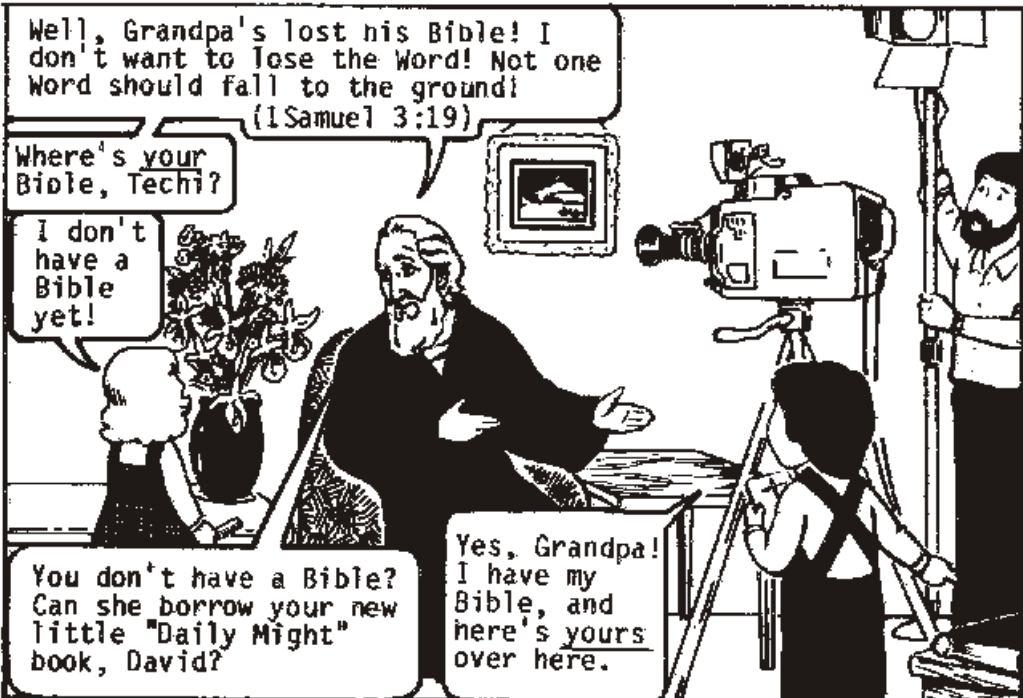
Well, Grandpa's lost his Bible! I don't want to lose the Word! Not one Word should fall to the ground! (1 Samuel 3:19)

JULY

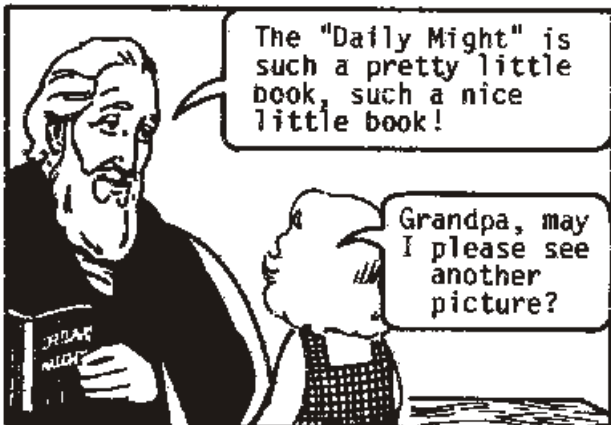
Oh my! Look at that!

Yes, it's His Shepherd's crook or staff! Remember how He takes it and puts it around the lambs' necks and saves the little lambs?

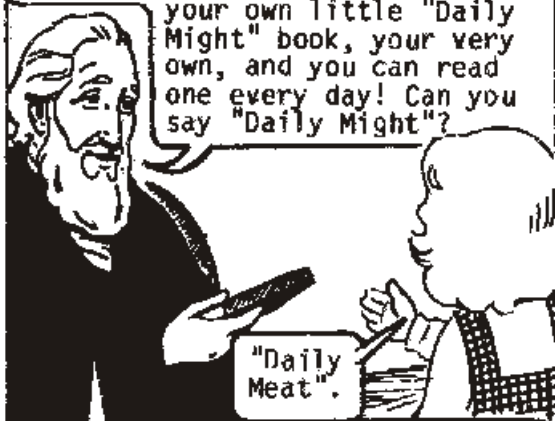
Like Snowflake!*

"Daily Meat" she says! Ha! Yes, it's spiritual food! It's daily strength for you.

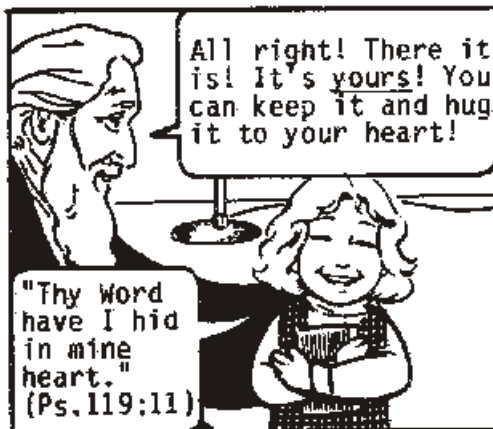
It's my own little bitty Bible!

Yes, but be careful! Don't bend it too much!



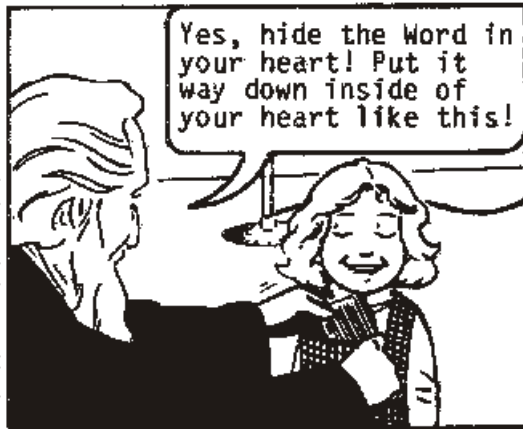
Don't twist it or fold it, or tear it, or be rough on it! You've got to

Look, Grandpa!


Oh look, Davida wants to show you she's hiding the Word in her heart too!

That's good, because one day the only Word of God you'll have may be what you've memorised and hidden away in your heart!




Ha! Look at David!

Thank you very much! Yes, let's put the Word in Grandpa's heart!

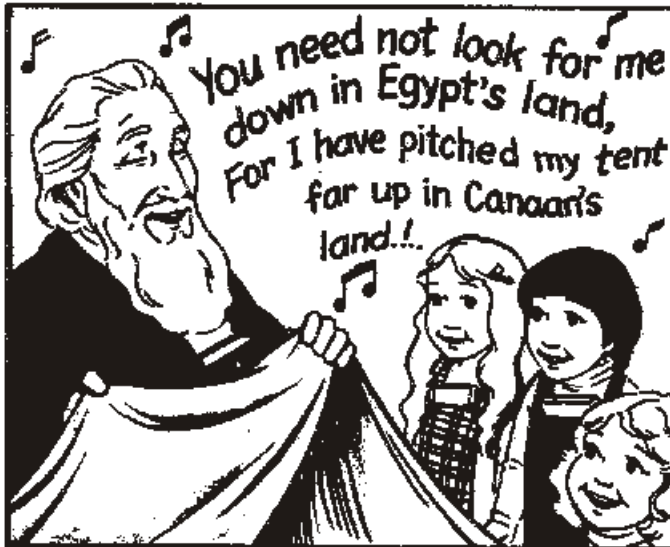
"Thy Word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against Thee! That I might not sin! That I might not sin! Thy Word have I hid in my heart!"

But you want your tent way up in Canaan's land, in Heavenly country, with the Lord and with the Family!

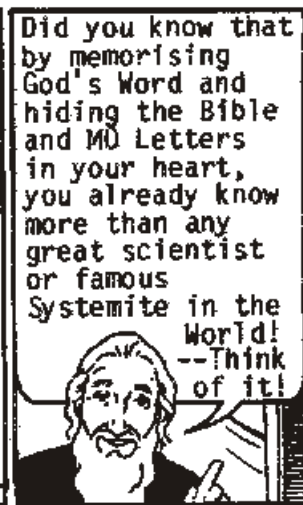
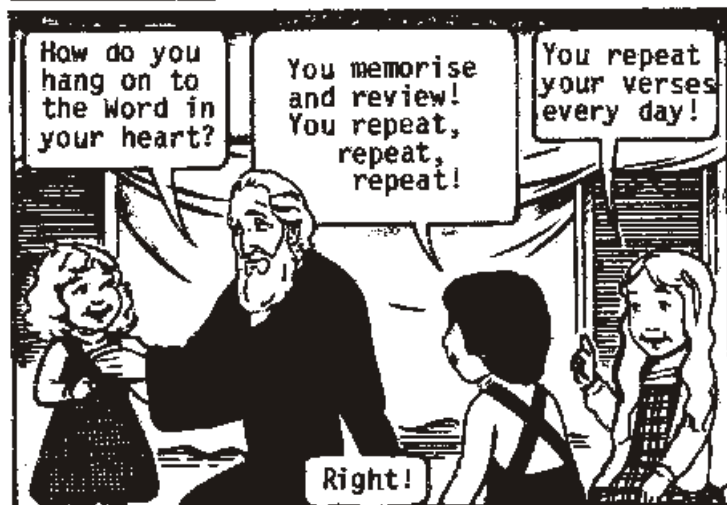


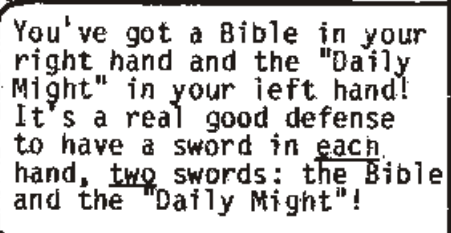
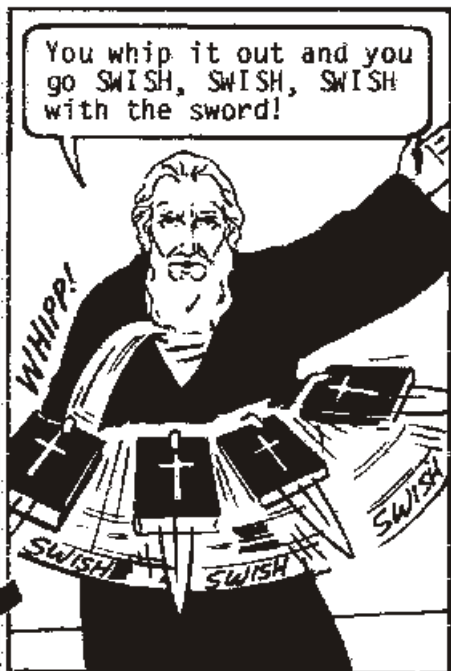
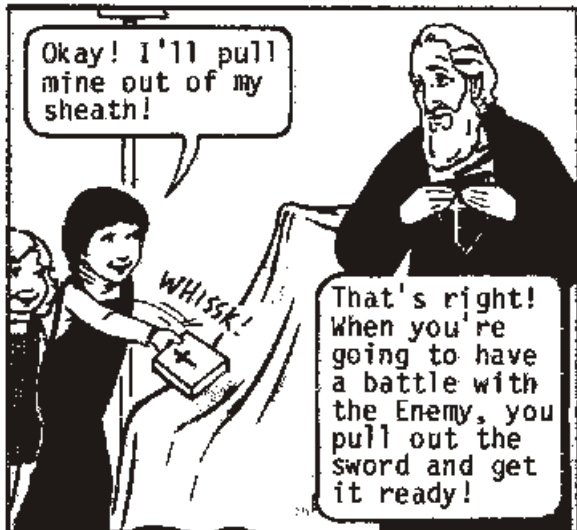
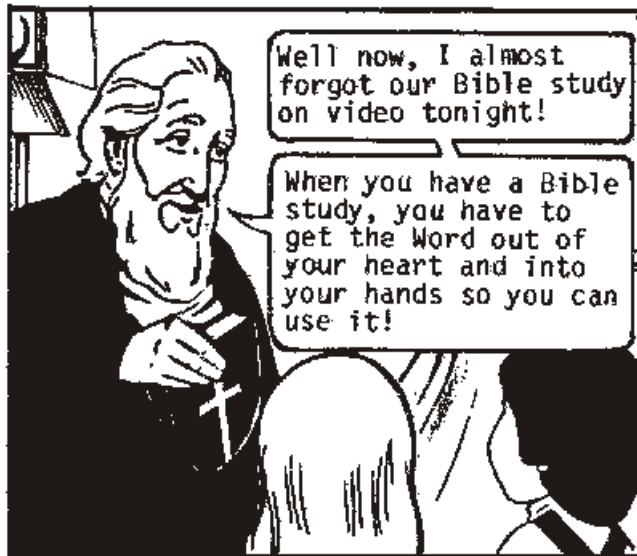
Do you think you can learn that song? Here we go again!
